THE BATTLE FOR BRIDGE SUPREMACY STARTS

The 9th edition of the **Mohan Lal Bhartia Memorial Grand Prix Bridge Champion** commenced yesterday at the Country Inn & Suites, Sahibabad.

The championship was inaugurated with the traditional lamp lighting ceremony by all the dignitaries on the dais, consisting of Mr. Uma Shankar Bhartia, Mr. Dipak Poddar, Mr. Hemant Jalan and Mr. Anand Samant, Secretary, Bridge Federation of India.

A total of 57 teams are participating in the Team of Four event, which consists of 8 rounds (each of 10 boards) of Swiss League, followed by 20-board knock out matches (2 * 10) in 5 stages.

Formidables, Dhampur Sugar Mills, India Glycols, Shree Cement, Shri Radhey, Arun Jain, Bangur Cement, India Blues & Poddar Housing are some of the top Indian teams participating.

At the end of yesterday's play (after 6 rounds), **ARUN JAIN (ARUN JAIN, S SARKAR, P BARDHAN, B DAS, A SADHU, P S MUKHERJEE)** lead the event with **88.45 VPs. DHAMPUR SUGAR MILLS (Ashok Goel, K.R. Venkatraman, Sumit Mukherjee, P. Sridhar, S. Sunderram)** are second with **87.46 VPs.** FORMIDABLES (82.23 VPs), KAMLESH GUPTA (80.06 VPs), COOKXON (79.12 VPs), SHRI RADHEY (77.69 VPs), PANKAJ MEHTA (77.58 VPs) & ANOOP DHAWAN (76.40 VPs) are holding the 3rd to 8th place in the event. The complete rankings after 6 rounds are given on *Page 7*.

Today there will be 2 more rounds, which are going to be very competitive, as teams lagging behind will try to catch up for the Last-16 berths. After 8 rounds of Swiss League, the TOP 16 teams will qualify for the knock-out stage. Vu-graph of the knock-out stage matches will be shown live on BBO starting today at 1400 Hrs.

The non-qualifying teams will play a 2-session Board-a-Match event from 1400 Hrs. today.



This was a funny deal, where six level minor suit contracts were always on but very difficult to reach after East's opening. In 6NT also, any lead except spade fetches 12 tricks. West led the HJ and declarer made his 12 tricks.

Lead was C10 and declarer won in hand, played diamond to Jack winning the trick and now playing SJ from dummy, west covering with SQ and won in hand. Declarer now has 3 tricks each in diamonds & spades, 2 in clubs and required only one more trick. With HK rightly placed, his only chance was to insert the HK, when East played low. But then the 2NT (minors bid) forced declarer to go wrong. He thought of end playing West in major suits. After winning 2 clubs, 3 diamonds and 3 spades, he gave a spade, hoping that West after cashing spades will be forced to play to dummy's heart for his 9th trick, but West took his 2 spades and played a low heart


to East's HA, who could cash the DQ & CA to defeat the contract.

After negative response from partner over his strong 1C opening, his 1NT showed 17-18 HCPs and South after Stayman enquiry showed invitational values. With maximum hand for his 1NT, North raised to 3NT.

This prompted East to lead his 4th best heart, West winning with Ace and returning HJ. Declarer did well to duck this but East was equal to the task, winning with HQ and leading another heart. Now declarer was doomed as he cannot get his 9th trick without playing spade as East can win the diamond with Ace, if declarer plays King or queen and duck, if declarer plays low. After winning he returns a club to dummy's Ace, killing the entry to dummy. Good defense.



In 3NT, East led the club and West put the king, when declarer played low. Declarer took the heart finesse losing to West, who returned the club. But declarer now had 7 tricks in major suits and defenders are forced to give one more trick in either clubs or diamonds.


In 4H, again the lead was clubs and declarer won with Ace and took the heart finesse losing to West, who returned back a club. Declarer ruffed, too out trumps and had to only give 2 diamonds to make 10 tricks. However, declarer has to be careful not to go for ruffing clubs in hand as he can not enjoy the 3^{rd} spade and will be one trick short.


South opened 1H on 3rd seat and when his passed partner opted for good raise in hearts, he could not imagine partner to have such a massive fit. He only bid 3H. On SQ lead, declarer won in hand, cashed top clubs discarding a spade. With hearts in, he lost only one more diamond to score 11 tricks. I think, North should not have got indulged in bidding jugglery and should have banged 4H directly with the massive fit.

Round 4, Board 1, Dealer: North, Vul: None



Should East bid 3C or 3NT with his hand? West surely will prefer playing 3NT with his hand if partner gives him choice of contract, but if East bids 3C, he will be aware of the spade danger.

It was really surprising that many players preferred going down in 3NT on spade lead, when 6D & 6H both were cold.



West did well to raise the diamonds, which prompted North to pass. Though North should have taken some action by doubling with his hand. With 1 spade, 2 heart and a club loser the contract was through. If North doubles, South would have bid 4C or even 5C. 4C was cold, whereas 5C would have gone one down but then also better than opponents getting 130.

In open room, where North bid 1S, South raised to 2S but on a 3H trial bid South opted for 3S, whereas 4S was making, even ifEast leads the DK and tries to get a ruff.
